

INFINITY'S NEW TAMPA OFFICE IS GREEN

As part of its Managed Services Accreditation Program[™], this Green IT certification is based on quantifiable standards driven by several factors, including reduction of power consumption in data centers and offices, increased use of remote management of IT services to reduce carbon emissions, and other recognized Green initiatives.

In order to achieve Green IT certification, IBS had to demonstrate proficiency in the following areas:

- Must be an accredited member of the MSPA
- Must be in good standing with the MSPA and abide by the MSPA code of ethics
- Must have a certain percentage of their clients managed remotely
- On-site remediation services not to exceed a certain percentage of total services revenue
- Percentage of trouble tickets must be performed remotely
- Proof of server and/or desktop virtualization implementations
- Data center power saving best practices
 - o Alternative energy sources
 - o Server virtualization
 - o Adoption of alternative data center cooling practices
- Must be able to demonstrate adoption of energy saving practices at client sites
